SUBJECT: Personal Services Contracts (PSCs) Annual Health Insurance Costs

CONTRACT INFORMATION BULLETIN 00 - 05

This CIB supercedes CIB 99-9

As a matter of policy, USAID provides a contribution against the actual costs of PSCs annual health insurance. As stated in paragraph 4(c)(2)(ii) of the Appendix D, such a contribution (1) shall not exceed 50% of the actual costs of the PSC. s annual health insurance, and (2) shall not exceed the maximum U.S. Government contribution for direct-hire personnel as announced annually by the Office of Personnel Management. For purposes of budgeting and making funds available, 2000 U.S. Government contribution rates for direct-hire personnel are as follows:

Contractor Only Not to exceed \$2,050

Contractor with Family Not to exceed \$4,575
