SUBJECT: CIB 01-08 Announcement for PHNO's

On January 22, 2001, President Bush issued a Memorandum to the Administrator of the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID), directing him to reinstate the Mexico City Policy (MCP), which had been in place from 1986 to 1993. The MCP was initially implemented through USAID's Contract Information Bulletin 01-03 that was issued on February 15, 2001. CIB 01-03 was cancelled on March 23, 2001 by instruction of President Bush, and President Bush issued a Presidential Memorandum on March 28, 2001 that sets forth the Mexico City Policy as a White House policy rather than an Agency contract information bulletin.

The March 28, 2001 Presidential Memorandum, transmitted by CIB 01-08, provides paragraphs that will be included, as specified in the memorandum, in all new grants and cooperative agreements awarded by USAID that provide assistance for family planning activities. The paragraphs will be included in existing grants and cooperative agreements for family planning activities when they are amended to add new funds. These paragraphs are identical to the ones included in CIB 01-03 [although the exceptions laid out in the cover page of CIB01-03 now appear in Section III].
