
# Global Health Supply Chain Program – Procurement and Supply Management

Since project inception, the USAID Global Health Supply Chain Program–Procurement and Supply Management (GHSC-PSM) has been collaborating with USAID and the Ministry of Health's vertical programs to forecast and conduct supply planning, as well as procure and deliver essential health commodities, such as antiretroviral treatments, viral load and early infant diagnosis kits, voluntary medical male circumcision kits,

antimalarial drugs, long-lasting insecticide treated nets, family planning supplies, and other essential medicines.

# **HIV/AIDS Commodity Procurement**

The 95-95-95 objective to guide efforts to combat HIV/AIDS calls for 95% of Tanzanians to know their status, 95% of people diagnosed with HIV infection to receive sustained antiretroviral therapy, and 95% of those on antiretroviral therapy to have viral suppression by 2025. GHSC-PSM is a key partner of the National AIDS Control Program (NACP) in helping Tanzania

meet the 95-95-95 objective before 2025. As USAID's principal agent for the procurement and delivery of HIV commodities, GHSC-PSM has worked to ensure an uninterrupted supply of HIV commodities through its continuous consultation with USAID, NACP, Global Health Supply Chain Technical Assistance – Tanzania Program, and other stakeholders in Tanzania. Since project inception, GHSC-PSM has delivered nearly half a million early infant diagnosis tests, more than 1.5 billion antiretroviral tablets, and 8.6 million viral load tests. As part of the GHSC-PSM Viral Load Initiative, Tanzania has benefitted from an estimated \$20 million in cost savings for viral load reagents by promoting increased competition and establishing transparent and all-inclusive reagent rental prices.

As part of the United States Government's commitment to HIV prevention, GHSC-PSM procures commodities aimed at reducing the transmission of HIV in Tanzania. Recognizing the effectiveness in voluntary medical male circumcision as an approach to prevent the transmission of HIV, GHSC-PSM has delivered more than 2.3 million voluntary medical male circumcision kits for USAID, U.S. Center for Disease Control, and U.S. Department of Defense's implementing partners in Tanzania. Additionally, GHSC-PSM has procured nearly 11 million tablets of pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) for individuals at high risk of contracting HIV. The project has also delivered more than 76 million male condoms for USAID's social marketing partner, TMARC.

## **Malaria Commodity Procurement**

GHSC-PSM is a partner to the National Malaria Control

Program and the Zanzibar Malaria Elimination Program in their efforts to eliminate and treat malaria. On Tanzania's mainland, there are an estimated 7.7 million confirmed and clinical malaria cases per year, with 26% of outpatient visits attributable to malaria. Since 2017, GHSC-PSM has delivered more than 19.2 million long-lasting insecticide treated nets, which have been distributed by the USAID Tanzania Vector Control Activity for the school net distribution campaign and as part of antenatal appointments. Additionally, GHSC-PSM has delivered nearly 9.2 million malaria rapid diagnostic test kits and nearly 16.5 million first-line malaria treatments and nearly 3 million vials of severe malaria treatment.

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# **Family Planning and Reproductive Health Commodity Procurement**

Access to voluntary family planning and reproductive health services is vital to safe motherhood and health families. In 2022, 24.7% of Tanzanian women had an unmet need for family planning. GHSC-PSM is working with USAID and Tanzania's Reproductive and Child Health Services to address this gap through the provision of family planning and reproductive health commodities. Since 2016, GHSC-PSM has procured and delivered commodities that have helped to prevent three million unintended pregnancies, 6,000 maternal deaths, and 65,000 child deaths in Tanzania.
