SUMMARY: The United States Agency for International Development (USAID) gives notice that it has prepared a Privacy Impact Assessment (PIA) summary for the Enterprise!® Loan Management System (ELMS). ELMS is a robust, feature-rich platform designed to support complex loan, deal and ownership structures.

What elements of PII are being collected? Based upon the Information Collection Checklist submitted by the System Owner, the only collection of information is the collection of name.

Why is the PII being collected? The name is required to identify contact personnel.

What opportunities are provided to individuals to consent to the use of this information collection? No opportunity for consent is required as the use is specific for the system.

What is the Agency's intended use of the information? The name is being collected in order to identify contact persons at USAID Missions/Accounting Stations.

Who has access to the information? USAID Washington DC Staff and Midland Loan Services, Inc.'s Government Services Staff and the Information Technology Staff.

Information Security The name is a public data element within the ELMS.
