



## HEALTH FINANCE AND GOVERNANCE (AMPLA SAUDE)

June 2011 – September 2019 Total Funding: \$ 654 thousand

Ampla Saude increases the use of priority health services, like primary health care, through improved governance and financing systems in the sector. This activity provides technical support in the design, implementation, and monitoring of the Government of the Republic of Angola's National Health Development Plan 2012-2025. The plan includes budgeting for 47 projects across the health sector.

Ampla Saude will develop a detailed budget for the Government's Plan using the World Health Organization's OneHealth Tool which allows the Ministry of Health access to programmatic and financial planning tools.

## **ACTIVITIES**

- Design of monitoring and evaluation tools for tracking Angola's National Health Development Plan results
- Perform data tracking for national health expenditures to improve efficiency, equity and financial sustainability in health sector

- Produced National Health Development Plan budget using the WHO's One Health Tool
- Supported collection of National Health Development Plan project data to feed the WHO's

- Produced a validated and benchmarked health plan
- Supported Ministry of Health to develop and update the health accounts work plan and the data collection work plan
- Trained Ministry of Health staff to use the One Health Tool
- Presented findings to the Multi-Sectorial Commission of the National Health Development Plan
