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## PRIVACY IMPACT ASSESSMENT SUMMARY

**System Name:** OIGNET

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**SUMMARY:** The United States Agency for International Development (USAID) gives notice that it has conducted a Privacy Impact Assessment (PIA) of the OIG GSS. The OIG GSS is the interconnected set of information resources under the common management control of, and which provide the common functionality as the local area network (LAN) for the USAID Office of the Inspector General.

**What elements of PII are being collected?**

OIG collects data which may contain any Human Capital, Financial Resources, Investigative, or Audit data. OIGNET is the platform on which our minor systems operate.

**Why is the PII being collected?**

OIG uses this Information on the OIGNET and is used in the day-to-day operation and management of OIG.

**What opportunities are provided to individuals to consent to the use of this information collection?**

No opportunity to consent is provided, as this information is authorized for collection.

**What is the Agency's intended use of the information?**

OIG uses this Information on OIGNET in the day-to-day operation and management of OIG in the review and management of audited data.

**Who has access to the information?**

OIG staff and contractors as needed will have access to the data.

**Information Security**

The information is maintained on OIG servers with strict access controls. Role-based security is used to ensure that data is restricted to only users whom require access.

**Does this collection require a System of Record Notice?**

No. Information is not indexed based on PII. Information is maintained by users and removed as needed.
