



Request for information (RFI)

USAID Ethiopia is currently engaged in a five-year program to construct new and renovate existing Health Centers in different regions of Ethiopia in partnership with the Ethiopian Federal Ministry of Health (FMoH). USAID would like to receive RFIs from:

1. **Class I - Class III A/E Consultants [Architectural and Engineering consultants]:** to oversee quality, progress and safety of new construction and renovation of existing facilities; provide feedback on the design and methodology; recommend design modifications and material changes if need be; and monitor all on-going construction activities at all the sites.
2. **Class I – Class III General / Building / Contractors:** to construct new health centers and renovate existing health facilities as per the provided drawings and technical specifications.

The purpose of this RFI is to collect written information about the capabilities of Ethiopian firms engaged in construction and A&E services. The information will be used to help make a planning decision and the requested information will not be released publically.

The firms who are interested in being considered should submit information supporting their experience, expertise, and capabilities in undertaking similar work. The following information on adequacy and capability should be provided:

- Name, address and email address;
- Names and short CVs of the key staff with address of references;
- Valid Business Registration Certificate, License and Tax Payers Registration Certificate; and
- A profile of the firm demonstrating a proven track record and ability to perform the work.

In accordance with FAR 15.201(e), responses to this RFI are not offers and cannot be accepted by the Government to form a binding contract. The result of this market research will contribute to determining the method of procurement. Telephone inquiries will not be accepted or acknowledged and no feedback or evaluations will be provided to companies regarding their submissions.
