1. **General**, Is it a requirement that all or part of the consulting team must be Niger Citizen or the firm's resources and experience in Sahel and west Africa are the most sought?

A: The solicitation is for either Nigerien or Regional West African firms.

2. **On Section Section H, paragraph H.5, page 26**, is the local contractor in charge of assessing taxes for foreign government or the individual consulting member has the duty of paying taxes and the contractor has only the duty of reporting?

A: The U.S. Government funds are exempt from foreign taxes. It is the implementing Partner's responsibility to obtain tax exempt status. Commodities purchased at a value of \$500 or more, by the implementing contractor should be exempt from taxes. The report to USAID is required if the contractor did or did not pay any taxes during the implementation period.

3. **On Section H, paragraph H14, page 29**, in case a permanent US resident (Tax payer) or business entity partner with local contractor to bid and execute this mission, is this section applicable when the resident travel to Niger/Senegal? And how it should be implemented to be proper?

A: The International Travel provision is applicable to all travel from one country to another regardless of resident status.
