

Question No. 1: If an international parent company has a local subsidiary located in West Africa (locally managed and operated, and works in accordance with the local legal framework, paying taxes and complying with local labor laws and the tax code), is that local subsidiary considered a Regional West African Contractor?

Answer No. 1: Yes, the local subsidiary is considered a Regional West African Contractor.

Question No. 5: Please provide a French version of the RFP if available.
