




THE UNITED STATES IS THE LARGEST SINGLE DONOR TO THE CRISIS IN SYRIA

Emergency food aid is reaching more than 5.6 million people, both inside Syria and refugees in neighboring countries. The U.S. supports more than 40% of this assistance.



BACKGROUND

- ▶ Three years of conflict in Syria
- ▶ 160,000 people killed during the conflict
- ▶ More than 60% of Syria's population is in need of humanitarian assistance


