

Feeding Central African Republic Refugees

Armed conflict and political instability in the Central African Republic (CAR) has **displaced over 385,000 people** and caused more than **452,000 refugees** to flee to neighboring countries as of September 2016. USAID's Office of Food for Peace (FFP) supports the UN World Food Program (WFP)'s refugee food assistance operations in Cameroon, Chad, Democratic Republic of Congo, and Republic of Congo. FFP supports WFP in a variety of activities to **decrease food insecurity and malnutrition** among refugees from CAR, including general food distributions, cash transfers, food vouchers, and targeted and supplementary feeding for pregnant and lactating women and young children. In FY 2016 FFP has provided more than \$48 million for these interventions.
