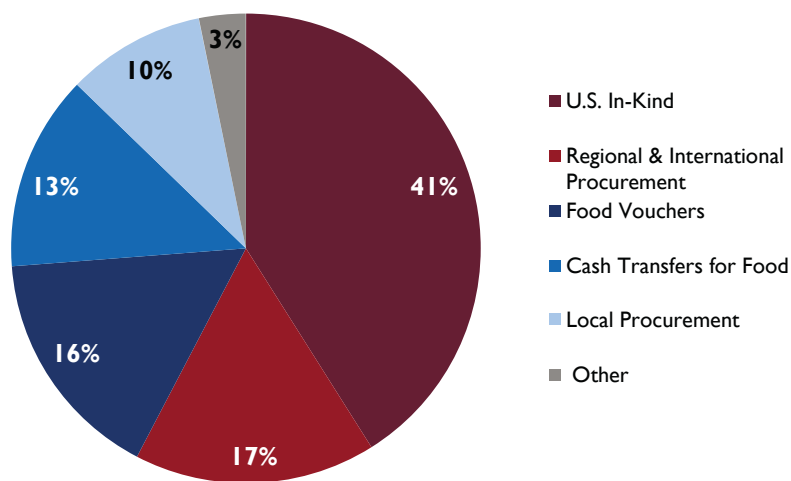




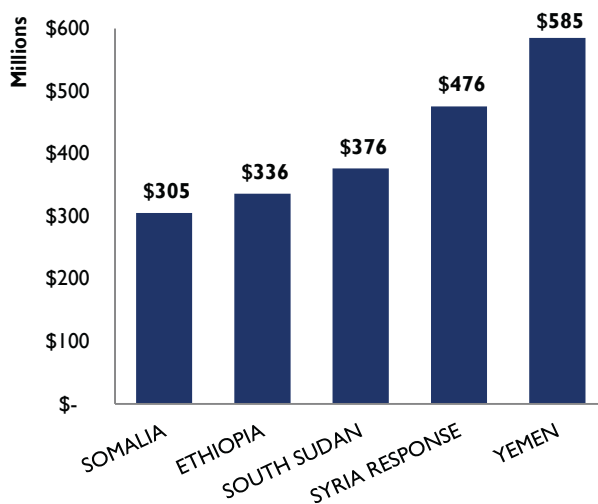
In FY 2019, USAID's Office of Food for Peace reached tens of millions of people in 55 countries.
