RE: Amendment to the GLOBAL PROGRAMMATIC INITIAL ENVIRONMENTAL EXAMINATION (P-IEE) for Long Lasting Insecticidal Nets (LLINs) in DCHA/OFDA Humanitarian Assistance Programs


Pursuant to the GLOBAL PROGRAMMATIC INITIAL ENVIRONMENTAL EXAMINATION (P-IEE) for Long Lasting Insecticidal Nets (LLINs) in DCHA/OFDA Humanitarian Assistance Programs signed 30-August- 2011, this (P-IEE) is being amended as follows.

1. In addition to the 3 (three) LLINs noted in the original P-IEE, (Olyset, PermaNet 2 and PermaNet 3), 4 (four) additional nets are approved for purchase and / or distribution in USAID / OFDA funded projects. The table below lists the 7 (seven) USAID / OFDA approved nets and their manufacturers.

Insecticide Treated Nets (LLITNs) for malaria and other vector borne disease control and mitigation activities as part of OFDA humanitarian disaster assistance worldwide”.
